

Congress reauthorizes the farm bill every five years. Later this year Congress will need to reauthorize this bill. The impact of the farm bill is significant. It not only affects the agriculture and food sectors--it can play a huge role in ending food insecurity and hunger in the U.S. and save the lives of millions abroad As people of faith, Proverbs 31:8-9 speaks plainly about our responsibility to advocate for those who are hungry. "Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are destitute. Speak up and judge fairly; defend the rights of the poor and needy." Sunday, May 7, will be Letter Writing day to urge our Congressmen to "support the reauthorization of the Farm Bill in order to build healthy, equitable and sustainable food systems". Writing packets will be available in the Pit Stop from 9 am until after worship. Packets contain a sample letter and writing supplies. The Offering of Letters (dedication) will take place during Worship on May 21. The letters will be mailed from the church during the following week.
