Join Bread for the World in pursuing a world without hunger. Please take a few minutes to write to North Carolina's members of Congress *"to urge them to support reauthorization of a farm bill that builds healthy, equitable and sustainable food systems."* The farm bill is our nation's most important national food system legislation. It is critical to the work of ending hunger at home and abroad. Indeed, the farm bill impacts each one of us. One of the specific requests included in the sample letter is to eliminate barriers to SNAP for marginalized populations; for example, eliminate the 20 hour/week work requirements for college students. Letter writing packets will be available in the Pit Stop on May 7 and in the Church Office during regular hours.
